**PAYMENT POLICY:**

**Payment is required upon rendering of services.**

Your choice of payment methods are cash, check or credit card (Visa, Master Card and Discover).

- Deposits may be required on major medical/surgical cases, trauma cases and emergency work where hospitalization is required.
- We do not carry open accounts and hope the above alternatives are convenient.

**BOARDING/HOSPITALIZATION POLICY:**

- To prevent the spread of infectious diseases and parasites, hospitalized, boarded or pets here for grooming must be current on all vaccines (including Bordetella every six months for dogs) and be free of internal and external parasites (fleas and ticks). Dr. Doolittle must have examined your pet(s) being boarded or groomed at least annually. I authorize Dr. Doolittle's Animal Hospital to provide vaccines, parasite control, and an annual exam when needed.
- If tranquilizers or general anesthesia is necessary for treatment or handling of my pet, I give permission to Dr. Doolittle's Animal Hospital to administer such medication.
- I also authorize Dr. Doolittle's Animal Hospital to do whatever is necessary to my pet should an emergency situation arise.
- Pets are released only during regular business hours. If I neglect to pick up my pet within 10 days from the time the scheduled boarding or treatment is complete, Dr. Doolittle's Animal Hospital may assume that the pet is abandoned and is hereby authorized to dispose of my pet as appropriate.
- Because boarding can be a stressful experience for some pets, we occasionally find that a boarding pet becomes ill (especially with diarrhea and/or vomiting) or injures itself away from home. This is usually not a serious illness (although on very rare occasions death can result) but it may require medical attention. Should this occur, please be assured that we will provide necessary treatment at your expense.
- Neither Dr. Doolittle's Animal Hospital nor Denise Doolittle, D.V.M. will be held liable under any circumstances on account of the care, treatment or safekeeping of my pet except for their respective gross negligence. Disputes, other than collection of your receivables, will be resolved through binding arbitration following applicable Texas law.
- Payment for all services rendered will be required when my pet is released.
